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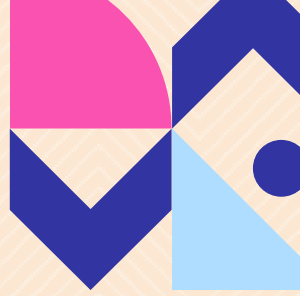

# Our Roots

Bombay Teachers' Training College, a premier college of education, is located in South Mumbai. The college was established in April 1969 as a grant-in aid, linguistic (Sindhi) minority institution by the Hyderabad (Sindh) National Collegiate Board. It is an English medium, co-educational institute.

It was the vision of the founders of the H.(S.)N.C. Board, 'Vidyasagar' late Principal K.M. Kundnani of K.C. College and a legal luminary Barrister Hotchand G. Advani who realised the need and importance of teacher education. Both these eminent personalities played a pioneering role in the field of higher education in Mumbai. Beginning with conventional degree courses, the H.(S.)N.C. Board continued to set up institutions of specialized learning. Today, the Board manages a chain of professional, vocational and job oriented courses in various disciplines, and is one of the largest educational corpus in Mumbai & Thane District.

The college shifted to its current premises at Apollo Bunder in May 1991. Dr. K.T. Bhatia, Dr. M.M. Lulla and Dr. Mintu Sinha took the college to even greater heights. Dr. Bhagwan Balani, the current I/C Principal took charge of the college in 2018. The college has been accredited thrice with an 'A' grade in 2004, 2011 and recently in December 2016.

BTTC has become a resource centre in education due to its prominent achievements in teacher preparation, in-service training, research, extension services, co-curricular activities and add-on courses. The alumni of the college are well-placed in esteemed educational institutions both locally as well as globally.

The Hyderabad (Sind) National Collegiate Board was founded in 1949 by Barrister Hotchand G. Advani and Principal K. M. Kundnani. Both these eminent personalities played a pioneering role in the field of higher education in Mumbai. 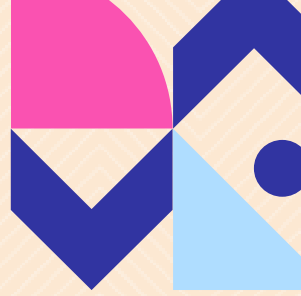

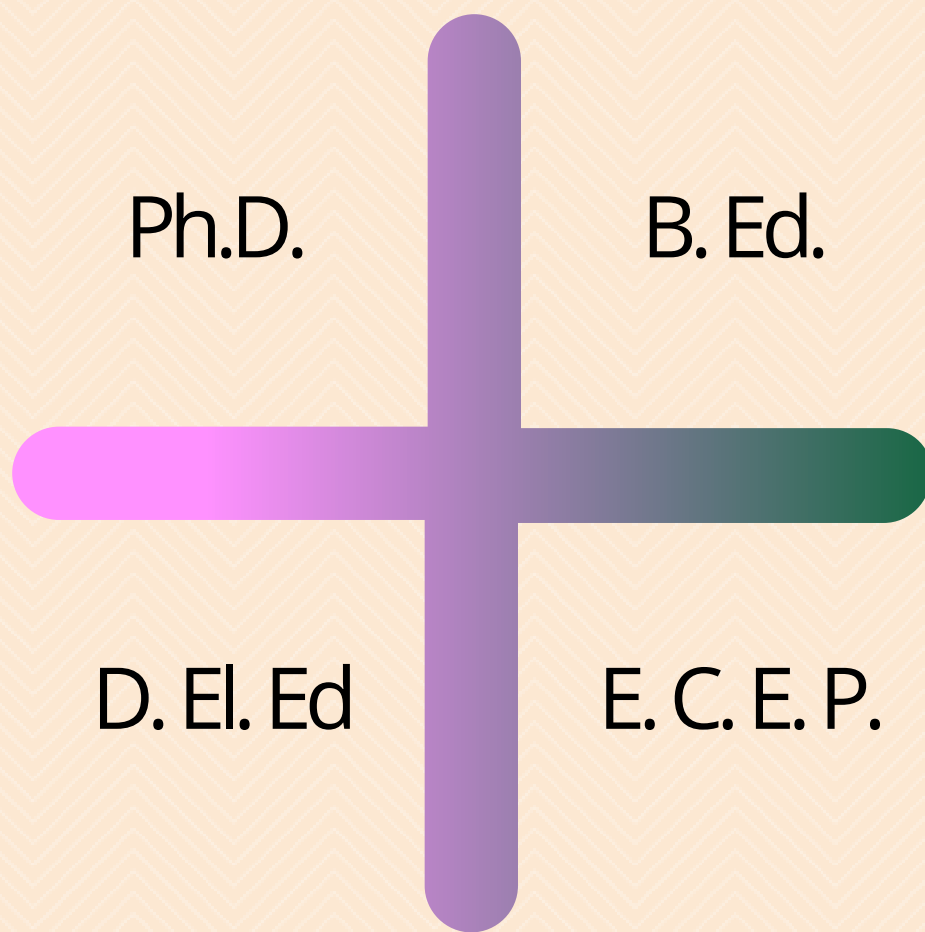
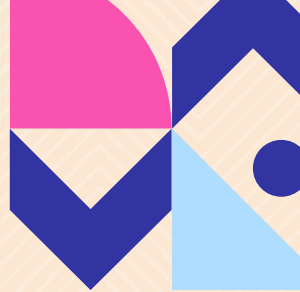

# Facilities

**Class-rooms** The college has smart class-rooms and LCD along with a personal computer installed in the each classroom for use by the staff and students. The college also has Overhead Projectors, Audio Equipment, a VCD Player and LCD televisions, and other equipment which are often used in the teaching-learning process.

**Psychology Laboratory** The college has a collection of Psychology Laboratory Materials which has a number of psychological tests and the required equipment for conducting educational psychology experiments.

**Curriculum Laboratory** The college maintains a well equipped curriculum laboratory which serves to house various resources for the teaching of science, mathematics and geography. There is equipment for conducting experiments and demonstrations in all the three branches of science. The lab also has resources for mathematics such as geometrical kits. For history and geography teaching there are a number of globes and maps.








# Facilities

**Computer Laboratory** The college has a well-equipped computer laboratory with Internet connection and wifi facilities. The laboratory has 25 personal computers with the latest configurations especially for use by the students. Each computer is equipped with a set of headphones. The laboratory is utilised for conducting hands-on activities for Critical Understanding of ICT course. The students use the lab for creating e-resources, digital lesson plans, submission of assignments, e-portfolio, presentations, etc.

The college has a well-equipped computer laboratory with Internet connection and wifi facilities. Each computer is equipped with a set of headphones. A collection of ICT and learning resources like educational softwares, CDs and DVDs are located within the computer laboratory. The laboratory is managed by a qualified computer instructor. Assistance is provided to students for their ICT requirements.





# Facilities Library



The Bombay Teachers' Training College Library supports education and research at BTTC through its collection of printed and electronic information. We are subscribing to N-List database from INFLIBNET where students can access E-books and E-journal from anywhere, any time. Our reading room-cum-library provides facilities for individual study. We also have a considerable collection of academic resources in various formats such as print, audio and video CDs. The Library subscribes to journals from reputed publishers in the field of education such as NCERT, NCTE, IGNOU, NUEPA etc.

The Librarian conducts information literacy workshops which offer advice on copyrights and publications and how to access open publications for research as well as teaching-learning purpose. The library opens on all working days of the college from 9am to 5.40pm. The BTTC library is automated with SOUL software and the entire collection is bar coded. The Library provides computers with internet connection to students to facilitate learning. The library also subscribes to one international journal "Journal of Teacher Education" from Sage publications and four online journals from Imangers. The students of B.Ed and D.T.Ed are provided Book Bank facility where 90% of D.T. Ed students and 30% of B.Ed students avail this facility every year.

BTTC Shiksha is a maiden attempt by the Bombay Teachers' Training College to introduce the use of a Learning Management System for curriculum transaction in teacher education.

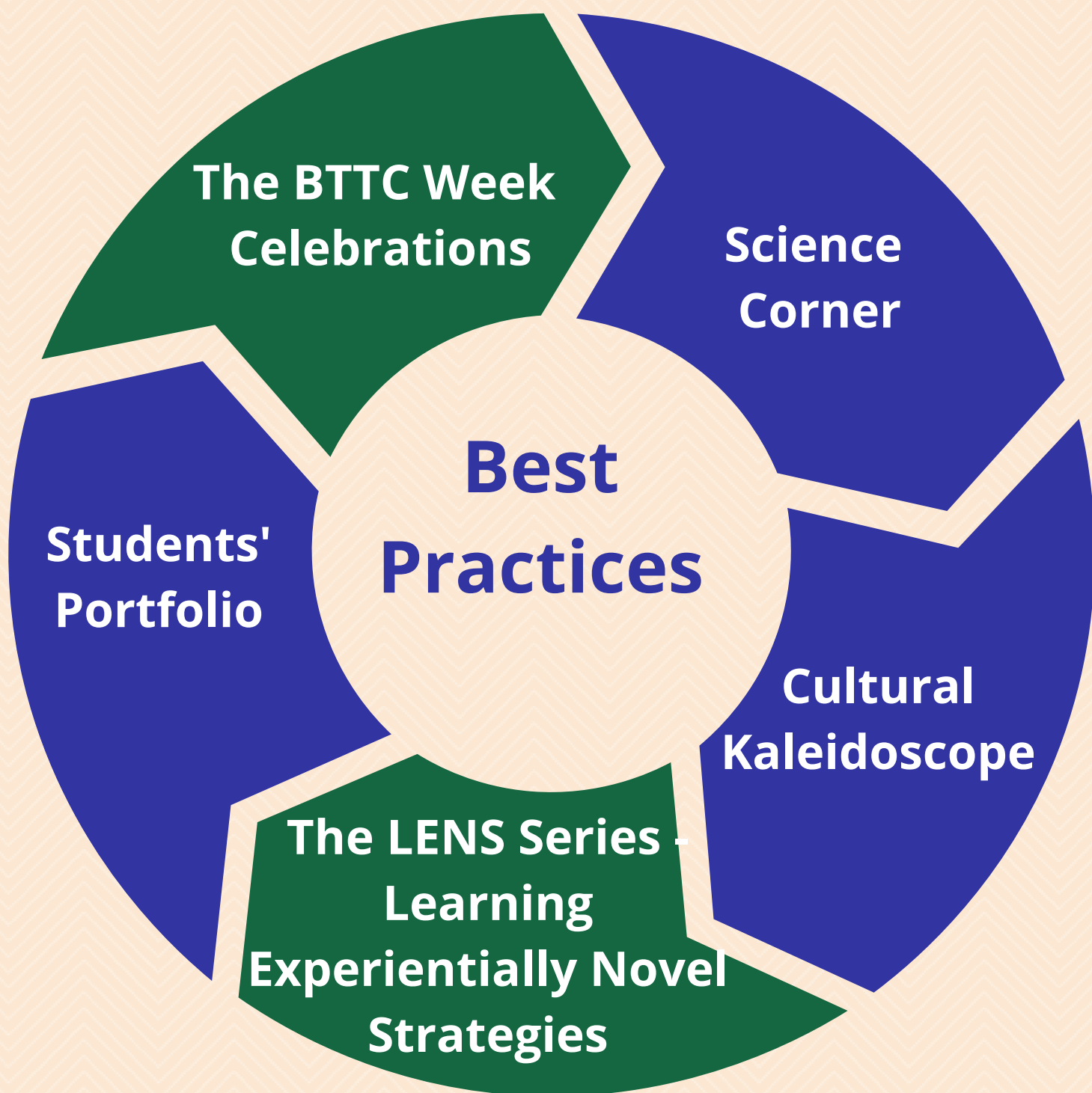

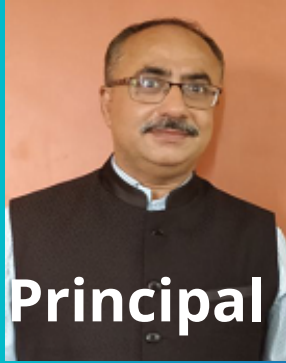
