Health Sciences study all aspects of health, disease and healthcare. KU SHS, aims to impart the knowledge to its students for use in healthcare sector. Degrees in Health Sciences include knowledge from other fields, such as natural sciences, technology, engineering and mathematics, which can be applied in clinical healthcare research and practice, and in public health education. The B-Pharma and D.Pharma courses offered by our School of Health Sciences are approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), New Delhi.

Kaziranga University offers degrees in Health Sciences at both the undergraduate & integrated levels.

Diploma in Pharmacy



Passed in any of the following examinations whether optional or compulsory subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology and or Mathematics including English as one of the Compulsory subjects with minimum 40% marks in aggregate).

Tuition Fee: Rs. 50,000 Per Semester

Bachelor of Pharmacy



Passed 10+2 examination or equivalent in Science stream with 45% (40% for SC/ST) marks in aggregate with PCM or PCB or PCMB as combination with English as one of the subjects.

Tuition Fee: Rs. 60,000 Per Semester

MSc - Microbiology



Passed BSc with minimum of 45% or more marks in Microbiology/Zoology/Botany/Biotechnology from a recognized University or equivalent.

Tuition Fee: Rs. 30,000 Per Semester

BSc - Operation Theatre Technology



Passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology. Obtained at least 45% marks (40% in case of SC/ST category) in the above subjects taken together.

Tuition Fee: Rs. 30,000 Per Semester

BSc - Medical Laboratory Technology



Passed 10 + 2 with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Vocational course in MLS/MLT equivalent to 10+2 with minimum of 45% marks in aggregate (40% in case of SC/ST).

Tuition Fee: Rs. 30,000 Per Semester

BSc - Trauma Emergency & Disaster Management



Passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology. Obtained atleast 45% marks (40% in case of SC/ST category) in the above subjects taken together.

Tuition Fee: Rs. 30,000 Per Semester

BSc - Advanced Imaging Technology



Passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology. Obtained atleast 45% marks (40% in case of SC/ST category) in the above subjects taken together.

Tuition Fee: Rs. 30,000 Per Semester

BSc - Dialysis



Passed 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Obtained atleast 45% marks (40% in case of SC/ST category) in the above subjects taken together.

Tuition Fee: Rs. 30,000 Per Semester

Bachelor of Physiotherapy



Passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology with 50% marks (45% for SC/ST category) in aggregate .

Tuition Fee: Rs. 45,000 Per Semester

Lateral Entry available for all undergraduate programmes and students can directly enter into 3rd Semester, subject to availability of vacancy on merit or entrance test.

Bachelor of Optometry



Passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology. Obtained atleast 45% in case of SC/ST category) in the above subjects taken together.
